SHOW RULES:

The show will be conducted under the Show Rules of the BSNSW. Birds to be shown in standard show cages complete with drinker, floor to be covered with budgerigar mixture as per the BSNSW Show Rules (NOTE: Plain Panicum is no longer accepted). No birds will be allowed to leave the venue prior to the presentation without the permission of the Show Manager. Birds in dirty show cages will not be judged.

Non Standard entries must have a sticker on the right side of the show cage identifying the variety/s. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to place this sticker.

All entry money to be paid to the Branch Treasurer, Judi Spadaro on morning of the show. All scratchings must be paid for.

No birds are to be removed from the staging during the show without the permission of the Show Manager.

Except for old pairs, teams and collections, this show is for owner bred birds. **YOUNG birds** must be in adult feather and be rung with **VIOLET 2015** closed rings.

Please Note: A result report for each exhibitor will be available at the completion of the show. All major awards, special cards and rosettes will be placed on the show boxes.

CATERING:

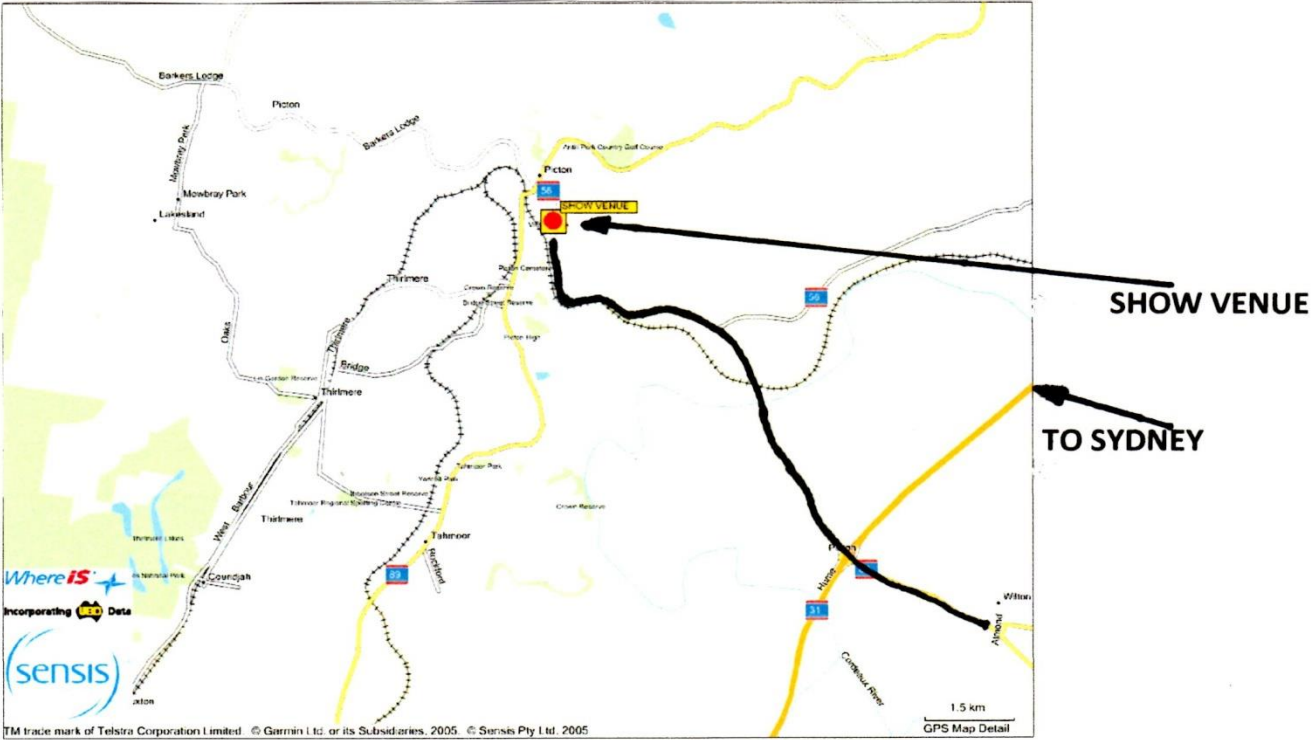
